A weekend is considered to be Friday 4:00 p.m. through Sunday, 4:00 p.m. Weekend rates will be applied for any portion of a weekend. Other periods of time will be pro-rated accordingly. Three weeks (3) weeks written notice is required for cancellation of reservation and full refund of fees. If less than three weeks, there will be a 10%, (minimum \$5.00) administration fee withheld from the refund. **RENTAL FEES ARE DOUBLED IF PAID AT CAMP.**

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

I, _____, the undersigned, representing the ORGANIZATION, have read and understand the policies for camp use fees and agree to pay for any damage to property, facilities, and/or equipment at Camp Holaka due to misuse or negligence. Further, I agree that the conduct of our group shall be in accordance with the current standards of the Boy Scouts of America and especially those specified in the Outdoor Code, Wilderness Use Policy, and the Scout Oath and Law.
