COUNSELOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM
CAMP TAPICO, BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA

A Counselor in Training (CIT) will be at least 14 years of age and a 1st Class Scout, but may be up to 17 year of age.

The idea behind the CIT program is to develop future staff members for Camp Tapico. It will give CIT'S an idea of what being on Staff at Camp Tapico is about, as well as, allowing Camp management to evaluate them for future job consideration.

The program runs in two-week blocks throughout Boy Scout Residence Camp. A CIT may choose any two weeks, but they must be concurrent. During their time at camp, they will participate in the following program areas: Aquatics, Eco-con, Shooting Sports, Handicraft, Scoutcraft, and Commissary. Due to the nature of C.O.P.E. and High Adventure, they will only get a brief inclusion of these areas. A CIT will rotate through the program areas during his 1st week at camp and then be assigned to an area for the 2nd week.

While at camp, a CIT will experience other aspects of camp to get a complete feel of a staff member's duties. He will be asked to participate in campfires, flag ceremonies, a camp service project, earn at least one merit badge per week, help with equipment moves, participate in camp-wide activities and general staff activities
