The Program consists of your Pack, Troop, Varsity Team, Crew or Post committing to participating in this program by following the steps below:

1. Fill out the slip below, mail or bring it into the Council Service Center. (Select a chairperson in your Pack, Troop, Team, Crew or Post to coordinate)
2. Work with District Chairman to identify a neighborhood of 1,000 or more homes to distribute Scouting for Food Collection Bags. **Bags can be picked-up at the February Roundtable.**
3. Distribute Bags on **March 10th** to homes in designated areas (follow the Buddy System)
4. Pick-up Bags of Food on **March 17th** from the same designated areas. If you don't see a bag, knock on the door (follow the Buddy System)
5. Take Bags to one of the Designated Drop-off sites. (Your District Chairman will inform you of drop off areas in your district)

A packet for Scouting for Food will be available at January and February Roundtables and from your District Chairperson.
